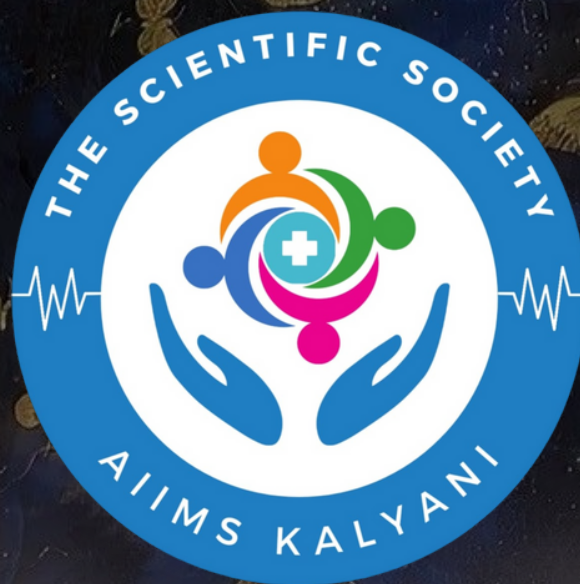

PRELIMS

- One has to write an abstract of the case.
- Word limit-250 words.
- Top 6 abstracts will be chosen by The Jury comprising of our faculties for the finals.
- There should be no breach of Patients Identity and Confidentiality.
- The Format should include :- Chief complaints, History of Present Illness, Past Medical history, Family History, Social History, Personal History, Investigations, Differential diagnosis, Final diagnosis, Follow ups and all other relevant subject headings to the case et cetera.

CLINICAL CASE PRESENTATION

- Cases can be taken from internet and other sources (plagiarism) but only up to 15% it will be tolerated . It will be strictly reviewed by our Jury.
- Failure to do above things will lead to disqualification.

FINALS

- It will be an Oral Case Presentation in front of the Jury.
- Participants have to make a power point presentation relevant to the case. Pictures can be given if they don't reveal patient's identity.
- Time for Presentation will be 5+2 minutes in front of the Jury followed by 3 minutes of case discussion and Q and A.
- Teams will be evaluated by the Jury based on time management, presentation and the questions they answer.
